Florida Gulf Coast Marine Mammal Stranding Network (preferred)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would maintain the Marine Mammal Stranding Network's capabilities (e.g., data collection, response, necropsies) to increase marine mammal survival through improving understanding of key causes of morbidity and mortality. This project would provide conservation managers critical and timely information needed to inform effective actions and plans aimed at mitigating or eliminating threats to marine mammal species. The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration would be the Implementing Trustees for this project.
