

## **Florida Restoration Area**

Reducing Threats to Sea Turtles Through Removal of In-water Marine Debris along Florida's Gulf Coast (preferred)

## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

This project involves reducing the threat and impacts of marine debris (e.g., entanglement, entrapment, ingestion) to sea turtle species along Florida's Gulf Coast. The primary focus would be on in-water derelict fishing gear (e.g., monofilament fishing line, nets, trap/pot gear, other recreational/commercial fishing equipment) that has been lost, abandoned, or discarded. This project would support actions identified in the Florida Marine **Debris Reduction Plan.** The Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission would be the Implementing Trustee for this project.

**RESTORATION TYPE** Sea Turtles

**ESTIMATED COST** \$3,667,400
