St. Vincent National Wildlife Refuge Recreational Improvements at Indian Pass (non-preferred)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This project would provide additional recreational improvements on the 10 to 15-acre Indian Pass parcel proposed for acquisition and enhancement through the “St. Vincent National Wildlife Refuge Access and Recreational Improvements through Acquisition at Indian Pass” project. This project would remove the existing boat ramp and construct a new double-lane boat ramp (with increased parking and monofilament recycling bins) and construct a trail system, picnic areas, and an observation deck. The U.S. Department of the Interior and the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission would be the Implementing Trustees for this project.


